Petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 6.10.2016 passed by the writ court. Operative part of the order reads as under: -

“Accordingly, a direction is issued to the respondents to complete the service book of the petitioner and make it up-to-date and to transmit it to the place where it is required in such a way as to not cause any disturbance in the petitioner's career. The service book be completed forthwith.

With these directions, the petition stands disposed of.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Shiv Kumar, LA, DEO XNR, submits that service book of the petitioner has been completed and updated. The same shall be transmitted to the place where it is required at the earliest in any case not later than two weeks.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition.

Accordingly, present petition has been rendered infunctuous.

Dismissed as such.

Rule is discharged.
