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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

The applicant/petitioner is stated to be a registered Charitable Trust, managing many properties including the arrangements of a *Mandir*.

It is alleged that one Ranviranand, alleged *Chela* of Krishnanand along with his anti-social friends was trying to usurp the properties of the Trust and the *Mandir* by creating false documents, apart from trying to take forcible possession of the properties.

It is stated that civil suit seeking injunction had also been filed, wherein temporary injunction stands granted. As the anti-social elements were still trying to interfere with the properties of the Trust and the Management of the *Mandir*, a representation dated 13.06.2016 (**Annexure P-3**) was made to the Deputy Commissioner, Mahendergarh at Narnaul to look into the grievance in the representation (**P-3**) and take strict action in accordance with law. The writ petition bearing CWP No.18495 of 2016, seeking the aforesaid relief, was disposed of by this Court vide order dated

06.09.2016, directing the Deputy Commissioner, Narnaul to look into the grievance raised and decide the same within three months. Since no action has been taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Narnaul, hence the present contempt petition.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince the Court as to efficacy or any remedy available by resorting to filing of the representation dated 13.06.2016 (P-3), in the background of the pending Civil Suits, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, the pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
