Short reply by way of affidavit of Jaskiran Singh, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana has been filed in court. Same is taken on record. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has referred to para 2 thereof. Same reads as under:-

“2. That the petition is liable to be dismissed as the petitioner has concealed the material facts from this Hon'ble Court. In compliance of Order dated 15.9.2016 (Annexure P-1), passed by this Hon'ble Court, the answering-Corporation has sent all the requisite documents to the office of Punjab Roadways, Ludhiana along with cheque no.034341 dated 6.3.2017 of Rs.11,794/- towards the retiral dues of deceased Gurmail Singh vide letter dated 8.3.2017 which was duly received by it on the same date. Hence the compliance on part of M.C. Ludhiana has complied with.”

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition. It is expected that the concerned authority shall do the needful at the earliest, in any case not later than three months. Petition is disposed of in these terms. Petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition in case any grouse still subsists.
