DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that order dated 25.4.2016 passed by this Court has been complied with and order dated 3.1.2017 (Annexure R-2) has already been passed.

A perusal of order dated 3.1.2017 clearly shows that only representation of the petitioners has been reconsidered/re-examined and the same has been ordered to be filed, which cannot be said to be a well reasoned and speaking order.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to pass a well reasoned speaking order within a period of two weeks only and in case the order is not passed within the specified period, the petitioners would be entitled to cost of ₹50,000/-.
