Vide order dated 19.10.2016, respondents No. 1 and 2 authorities of Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Hisar, were required to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner within a period of three months.

Alleging non-compliance, the present contempt petition has been filed.

An affidavit of Regional Officer, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Hisar Region, has been placed on record to the effect that in compliance with order dated 19.10.2016, the original bills were forwarded to the Head Office on 07.02.2017 and payment of Rs.66,500/- was made on 16.02.2017 to the Regional Office, Hisar and was given to the petitioner on 14.03.2017 and the same stands credited to the petitioner's account on 22.03.2017.

So far as pending bills of Rs.44,000/- are concerned, these were sent to the account branch for release of payment. The said payment has also been released and duly credited in the account of the petitioner.

In view of said circumstances, there does not appear to be any willful disobedience of the order.

In case, the petitioner is not satisfied with the amount disbursed, it will be open to the petitioner to avail the legal remedy available to him as direction of considering the legal notice has already complied with.

Disposed of with above observations.
