During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners has come up with twin prayers (1) he may be permitted to withdraw the revision petition subject to the condition that the amount already deposited as per the interim order passed by the Court, which is with the defendant/Corporation, would be returned along with interest, if ultimately the result of litigation is in favour of the plaintiff. (2) A request be made to the learned trial Court to decide the suit expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the respondents/Corporation does not have any serious objection.

In view of the above, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is agreed that if, ultimately the result of the

litigation goes in favour of the plaintiff, he will be entitled to the bank rate of interest on the amount deposited.

The suit is pending for the last 04 years. Hence, the learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial of the suit and make sincere efforts to complete the trial within a period of one year.
