Petitioner, by way of present revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeks directions to the learned Matrimonial Court to decide the divorce petition pending between the parties under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, at an early date.

Notice of motion was issued.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that prayer made by the petitioner is justified and deserves to be accepted. In the very nature of things, there was no scope of any opposition from the respondent as well.

In view of the above, the instant revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned trial Court to decide the divorce petition pending between the parties under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act as early as possible.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present civil revision petition is disposed of.
