Learned counsel for the petitioner/Judgment Debtor states that in compliance of the order dated 24.07.2017, the petitioner has already deposited Rs.25 lakhs. The said amount can be withdrawn by Decree Holder-Satwant Singh. The balance amount which would be deposited in six weeks, the same can also be withdrawn by Decree Holder.

Learned counsel for Judgment Debtor states that the validity of the earlier draft of Rs.15 lakhs deposited by Judgment Debtor has expired. The bank needs the original draft to revalidate the same. The trial Court should hand over the original bank draft of Rs.15 lakhs to Judgment Debtor who shall redeposit the same after revalidation. It is clarified that in case, the revalidated draft is not deposited within 15 days of receipt of the original draft, the stay order would stand vacated.

In view of the above statement made, the present civil revision is disposed of. In case any grievance occur, the parties are at liberty to revive the same.
