Office has listed the case on account of service upon the private-respondents being incomplete.

With the consent of counsel for the parties, the main case is taken on Board and is disposed of, today itself.

A perusal of the writ petition would go on to show that reference was made to CWP-6308-1991 titled *Constable Rajender Vs. State of Haryana & others*, wherein interim relief had been granted. In the present case the prayer is to direct the respondents to appoint the petitioner as ASI and to make appointment on merits, after quashing the appointments of respondents No.4 to 62. The matter was discussed in detail in CWP-5093-1991 titled *H.C. Ravinder Singh Vs. The State of Haryana & others*, which disposed of a bunch of cases on 07.01.1992, wherein also, the same selection was subject matter of consideration.

Record had been called for including the marks given for the written test as well as for the interview and the criteria fixed and the Court came to the conclusion that inspite of the fact that there was requisition of 98 candidates, only 62 had been recommended and therefore, the allegations that the members

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of the Board had to push in their favorites, was held not sustainable. Resultantly, the relief sought was denied regarding the challenge to the selection process and the writ petitions were dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the said findings and distinguish the same, especially once reliance itself had been placed upon the pendency of the said petition.

Accordingly, for the reasons recorded in CWP-5093-1991 on 07.01.1992 and CWP-6308-1991 on 09.01.1992, the present writ petition is dismissed, in the same terms.
