RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 10.01.2017, whereby the learned matrimonial Court directed the petitioner-husband to pay an amount of Rs.15,000/- per month only, for maintaining the minor child of the parties.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

A careful perusal of the impugned order would show that the learned Court below was well within its jurisdiction to pass the impugned order. It seems that the petitioner-husband is trying to run away from his responsibility even to maintain his own child, for which he is morally as well as legally bound. Unfortunate and unwarnated litigation between the husband and wife apart, the child must not be made to suffer. Petitioner-husband cannot be absolved from his responsibility to maintain his own minor child, who is

admittedly living with the respondent-wife. This seems to be the reason that the learned Court below was well justified in directing the petitioner-husband, only to pay the amount of maintenance for the child and not for the wife. Having said that, this Court feels no hesitation to conclude that learned Additional District Judge committed no error of law, while passing the impugned order and the same deserves to be upheld.

No other argument was raised.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case noted above, coupled with the reasons aforementioned, this Court is of the considered view that present revision petition is wholly misconceived, bereft of merit and without any substance, thus, it must fail. No case for interference has been made out.

Resultantly, with the abovesaid observations made, instant revision petition stands dismissed, however, with no order as to costs.
