RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J.(Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 on specific instructions from Sh.Mehnga Ram, respondent No.1 present in the Court, submits that since respondent No.1 is again residing with the petitioner, he has no objection if the impugned orders dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) and also the appellate order dated 24.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) are ordered to be set aside, allowing the present revision petition.

Further, petitioner who is also present in the Court has given an undertaking before this Court that he will keep on serving respondent No.1- his father Sh.Mehnga Ram with full sense of responsibility and sincerity. He further undertakes that in case any complaint is received by this Court, at the hands of Sh.Mehnga Ram against the petitioner, present order would be

re-called and the present revision petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

In view of the fair statements made on behalf of both the parties, impugned orders dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) and dated 24.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) are hereby set aside.

Resultantly, with the observations made, instant revision petition stands allowed in the above-said terms, however, with no order as to costs.
