This is plaintiffs revision petition against the dismissal of his application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC by both the Courts below.

On asking of the Court it has been informed by counsel for both the parties that the entire evidence of the parties has been led and the matter is pending before the trial Court for consideration of application for additional evidence filed by the plaintiff/ appellants.

In view of the stage of the suit, I am of the considered opinion that the ends of justice would be adequately met in case the trial Court finally dispose of the case on merits within a period of three months after the

receipt of certified copy of the order. Let the order be communicated to the trial Court.

Meanwhile, so far as the title of the property is concerned, in case the defendants intend to alienate the same, they will inform the name of the proposed vendee and will seek permission from the trial Court.

Appeal is disposed of with the above directions.
