The present application has been filed by respondent no. 2 for placing on record compromise deed dated 09.01.2017 and statements recorded before the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) (NRI Cases), Jalandhar as Annexures R-2 to R-4. Vide order dated 10.01.2017, it was noticed that there are chances of amicable settlement.
