RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Present revision petition, at the hands of the defendants, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is directed against the impugned order dated 25.1.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned trial court, whereby application of the petitioners for staying the proceedings of present suit, during the investigation of FIR No.131 dated 9.11.2014, was dismissed.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

A careful perusal of the impugned order would show that learned trial court was well within its jurisdiction to pass the impugned order. In fact, the impugned order has been found based on sound reasons and no interference has been warranted at the hands of this Court. It is a

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matter of record that issues had already been framed in the present suit and trial has already commenced. Suit was already fixed for plaintiff evidence when the application for staying the proceedings of the suit was filed by the petitioners-defendants. Since the impugned order has been passed by learned trial court in consonance with the settled proposition of law, referred at page Nos. 12 and 13 of the paper book, no fault can be found with it and the same deserves to be upheld.

No other argument was raised.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the cases noted above, coupled with the reasons aforementioned, this Court is of the considered view that present revision petition is misconceived, bereft of merit and without any substance. Thus, it must fail. No case for interference has been made out.

Resultantly, with the abovesaid observations made, instant revision petition stands dismissed, however, with no order as to costs.
