Feeling aggrieved against the alleged long pendency of the Civil Suit No.357 of 2011, plaintiff has approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to the learned trial Court to decide the civil suit at an early date.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the abovesaid prayer made, since no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent-defendant in granting the abovesaid prayer, present revision petition is being decided without any notice to the other side.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that petitioner approached this Court at an earlier point of time by way of CR No.4219 of 2015, which was disposed of, by this Court vide order dated 08.07.2015 and the

same reads as under: -

“Petitioner-trust has filed this petition seeking direction to expedite the proceedings in the civil suit dated 27.04.2011.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the trial Court is directed to dispose of the suit, expeditiously.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of the abovesaid order passed by this Court, the proceedings of the suit have not made much progress. It is still at the stage of plaintiff's evidence. Petitioner-plaintiff has examined his witnesses, but their cross-examination is being deferred repeatedly and that too without any justified reasons.

In view of the above, present revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned trial Court to make an endeavour to decide the civil suit filed by the plaintiff-petitioner expeditiously so that rights of the parties are crystallized without any unnecessary delay.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
