The present petition directs challenge against order dated 31.01.2017 (P-3) passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rewari whereby the petitioners/plaintiffs have not been allowed to produce documentary evidence as evidence of the plaintiffs has been closed by order of the Court.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a serious prejudice shall be caused to the petitioners in case they are not permitted to tender documents in evidence.

Mr. S.K. Yadav, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No.1. None has caused appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5 despite service.

Counsel for respondent No.1 has got no objection if the petitioners are provided with one opportunity to tender into evidence documents but it may be left open to be decided by the trial Court as to whether the documents are to be put mark or exhibit.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of and the petitioners/plaintiffs are permitted to adduce documentary evidence but they shall be entitled to only one opportunity for the purpose subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to respondents No.1 to 5, by way of demand draft to be submitted before the trial Court on the date to be fixed for evidence (documentary) of the petitioners.
