Present revision petition, at the hands of wife, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is directed against the order dated 12.01.2017 passed by learned District Judge, whereby application filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, during pendency of the divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband, was dismissed, recording that an amount of Rs.32,893/- plus Rs.675/- was being paid every month by the respondent-husband for the minor child, who is living with the petitioner-wife.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is a matter of record and not in dispute that the petitioner-wife is also working. Her monthly salary is Rs.36,000/-. As the learned Court below has recorded in para 15 of the impugned order, respondent-husband is paying the amount of Rs.32,893/- plus Rs.675/- per month to the minor child towards

arrears of maintenance as well as monthly maintenance. He is paying this much amount w.e.f. 11.01.2016. It is also recorded by the learned Court below that after paying the abovesaid amount, husband is left with an amount of Rs.42,957/- per month. The abovesaid figures would make it crystal clear that the petitioner-wife is receiving monthly amount of about Rs.70,000/-, including her salary and maintenance, which is being paid by the respondent-husband for the minor child.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present revision petition.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
