Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 refers to an order dated 18.10.2016 passed by the learned trial Court, whereby the applicant-petitioner withdrew his suit with permission of the Court to file fresh suit. The order dated 18.10.2016 reads as under:-

*“Today, plaintiff deposited of Rs.5000/- in the DLSA, and receipt of the same produced by him in the court. On the other hand counsel for the defendant suffered statement to the effect that he has received Rs.5000/- cost from the plaintiff.*

*In view of the statement so made by counsel for the defendant and in view of the facts of application moved by the plaintiff for withdraw the civil suit on the technical ground with permission to the court to file the fresh suit by the plaintiff the instant suit stands dismissed as withdrawn and plaintiff is permitted to file fresh suit subject to law of limitation. File complete in all respect be consigned to the record room.”*

In view of the above-said changed circumstances, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the present revision petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Under the above-said peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, instant revision petition is ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
