Vide this common order, both these revision petitions bearing CR Nos. 2112 and 3085 of 2014 are being decided together as both these petitions raise identical question of law.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for respondent No. 2 – Housing Board, Haryana – beneficiary department, has placed on record the calculation sheet dated 21.03.2017 and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners – land owners. The calculation sheet supplied to the

Court by the learned counsel for the Housing Board, Haryana is placed on record as mark 'A'.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that in view of the calculation sheet dated 21.03.2017, both these revision petitions may be disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the calculation sheet supplied by learned counsel for the respondent – Housing Board, Haryana, satisfies the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above said stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the impugned order is modified and both these revision petitions are disposed of. As agreed between the parties, the petitioners shall be entitled for the amount as per the calculation sheet dated 21.03.2017.
