**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.(Oral)**

This revision petition has been filed by the judgment-debtors against order dated 21.02.2017 dismissing the application filed by the judgment-debtors for framing issues as well as their objections.

Learned counsel for the decree-holder has drawn attention of the Court to order dated 30.05.2017 passed by the learned Executing Court, which reads as under:-

*“ Matter has been listed today on the request of DH side. DH has suffered a separate statement recorded in writing to the effect that he reserves the right to raise his own wall in the portion demolished on the orders of the court as per the site plan and withdraws the present execution being fully satisfied. He is duly identified by his counsel. In response, Randhir Singh JD has submitted that he has no objection, in case DH raises wall or any other construction on the portion that has*

*been demolished in pursuance of the orders of the court as per the site plan. JD is also identified by his counsel. Heard. In light of the report of the Local Commissioner dated 22.5.2017 and in view of the submission of the DH, present execution is hereby dismissed as withdrawn being fully satisfied. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.”*

Learned counsel has submitted that in view of this order, the revision petition has become infructuous because the execution petition itself has been withdrawn. A reading of the order further shows that the execution petition has been satisfied with the consent of parties.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, the revision petition filed by judgment-debtors has become infructuous. It is disposed of as such.
