RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J (ORAL)

After having been pointed out by learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3, that impugned order is appealable, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present revision petition, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the impugned order by way of appeal before the Appellate Forum. She also prayed that the respondents may be directed not to raise the issue of limitation against the petitioner, as he was pursuing this revision petition before this Court under a bonafide wrong impression.

In view of the above, permission is granted. The revision petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to file appeal against the impugned order, before the appropriate forum.

It is clarified that in case the appropriate appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today, the respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation, as the petitioner had been pursuing the present revision petition before this Court under a bonafide wrong

impression.
