Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 15.3.2016 (Annexure P-6), whereby application, under Order 1 Rule10 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure moved by respondent No.1-Harpal Singh, was allowed, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant revision petition.

Notice of motion was issued.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

After arguing the case at some length and realising that he will not be in a position to convince this Court on merits, learned counsel for the petitioners rightly submits that the petitioners shall be satisfied in case learned trial Court is directed to decide the suit expeditiously. This reasonable request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners is not opposed by the learned counsel for the contesting respondent No.1 namely Harpal Singh.

In view of the above, while upholding the order dated 15.3.2016, the learned trial Court is directed that keeping in view the nature of controversy involved, it shall make an endeavour to decide the suit at an

early date, however, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present revision petition stands disposed of, however, with no order as to cost.
