Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the execution petition filed by the petitioner is pending since 14.9.2016. The respondents- judgment debtors have already appeared through counsel but on one pretext or the other, the adjournment is being sought either to file the objections or for correction of revenue record and the adjournments are being liberally allowed by learned Executing Court. Learned counsel contends that his only prayer is that the execution petition be decided and the amount of compensation allowed to him be paid at the earliest. Copies of orders passed by learned Executing Court have been annexed with the petition.

To avoid unnecessary delay in the matter no notice is required to be issued to the respondents and the present petition is disposed of with a direction to learned Executing Court to expedite the proceedings of the execution petition and decide the same at the earliest.
