JASPAL SINGH, J.

Challenge in this revision petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated February 14, 2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) Dera Bassi, vide which an application moved by the petitioner-defendant under Order VII Rule 11 CPC for rejection of the plaint has been dismissed.

2. Undisputably, respondent/plaintiff filed a suit for recovery on the basis of pro-note and receipt dated June 06, 2008 along with interest on May 27, 2011 showing both the plaintiff and defendant residents of village Buddanpur, Tehsil Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar.

3. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner-defendant is that the Civil Courts at Dera Bassi has no jurisdiction to deal with and decide the suit in view of the letter No.20836 Gaz. II (2) dated

June 02, 2012 issued by the Registrar General, Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh and on this score alone, the plaint is liable to be rejected. But this court does not find any merit in the instant petition especially in view of the circumstances, as per the above referred letter dated June 02, 2012, civil and criminal work of 32 villages falling within the Sub Tehsil, Banur Revenue, District Mohali were shifted to the Courts at SAS Nagar (Mohali) but with a rider that the pending work be not disturbed. The instant suit was filed on May 30, 2011 and the list of 32 villages as per letter No.20836 dated June 02, 2012 which also includes village Buddanpur which at the time of filing of the suit was within the jurisdiction of Dera Bassi. Since, the fresh institution of the suits were shifted to the courts at SAS Nagar Mohali of 32 villages including Buddanpur, but the cases which are already pending prior to June 02, 2012 were to remain with the Civil Courts at Dera Bassi for its disposal. Moreover, this is not a ground for rejection of the plaint as the Civil Courts at Dera Bassi are also under the control and supervision of the District Judge, SAS Nagar Mohali. This court does not find any illegality or perversity in the impugned order dated February 14, 2017. Rather, this court is of the considered view that instant revision petition is nothing but devoid of merits. As such, it stands dismissed.

4. No order as to costs.
