The tenant is in revision against the impugned order dated 08.03.2017, passed by learned Rent Controller, Chandigarh, whereby the application under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC for amendment of the rent petition, filed by the landlords, has been allowed.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present petition has become infructuous as the dispute has been settled between the parties. In support, photocopy of order dated 29.08.2017, passed by learned Rent Controller, Chandigarh has been placed on record, wherein the tenant undertakes to hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the landlords on or before 31.05.2018, in terms of Ex.C-1.
