Instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, at the hands of defendants, is directed against the order dated 3.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned trial court, whereby application moved by the plaintiff under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure was allowed, impleading vendee of defendant No.1 as party-defendant.

After arguing the case for some time and having failed to convince this Court on merits, learned senior counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from petitioner No.1 who is present in Court, submits that he does not intend to press this revision petition any further. He further submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case the learned trial court is directed to expedite proceedings of the civil suit.

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In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned senior counsel for the petitioners, present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial court to make an endeavour to decide the civil suit at an early date.

Disposed of, accordingly.
