Through the instant civil revision petition preferred under Article 227 of Constitution of India, petitioner has sought direction to decide the execution petition No.31 dated 3rd August, 2013 captioned as “*Chand Kaur Vs. Attar Singh and others*” within a specified time.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the respondents illegally got executed a Will, 1971 bearing No.286 dated 22nd February, 1971 only to grab the suit property belonging of petitioner's father-Harphool Singh. The suit of the petitioner challenging the aforesaid Will was decreed vide decree dated 19th April, 2012. The first appeal preferred by the respondents was dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 28th September, 2013. Similarly, RSA preferred by the respondents bearing No.4679 of 2013 was dismissed by this Court vide judgment dated 15th July, 2014. Till date the execution application is lingering at the instance of the respondents/JDs and no serious efforts appears to have been made by the Executing Court.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to the Executing Court that the execution proceedings be expedited and disposed of on priority basis preferably, within a period of one year from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
