RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Faced with a strong objection raised by the learned senior counsel for respondents about the maintainability of the revision petition itself and unable to satisfy this Court on the issue of maintainability, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the court to withdraw the present revision petition, however, with liberty to challenge the impugned order dated 4.4.2015 (Annexure P-5) before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted as the same has been found to be a genuine one.

In view of the above, instant revision petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, however, with liberty as prayed for. It is also made clear that in case the impugned order is challenged by the petitioner before the appropriate forum within a period of one month from today, respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation against the petitioner as she has been pursuing her remedy before this Court under a bona fide wrong impression.

Disposed of, accordingly.
