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**RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)**

Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 21.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned executing Court, whereby the objections were dismissed, judgment-debtors have approached this Court by way of present civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

The only argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioners that since their first appeal as well as the stay application was pending before the learned first appellate Court, the learned executing Court ought to have stayed its hands to await the outcome of stay application of the petitioners. However, when asked to refer to any provision of law, which might be helpful to the petitioners in such a situation, learned counsel for the petitioners was unable to refer to any

provision of law and rightly so, because there would be no such provision of law, which might help the petitioners.

Faced with the abovesaid difficult situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not intend to press this revision petition any further. He also submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case the learned first appellate Court is directed to expedite the decision of their stay application without any further loss of time.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, present revision petition is disposed of. However, the learned first appellate Court, before whom the first appeal as well as stay application of the petitioners is pending, is directed to expedite the decision of the stay application, by passing an appropriate order, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
