Defendant/petitioner is in revision petition against order dismissing application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC for the rejection of the plaint on the ground that *ad valorem* fee has not been paid on the relief of possession. It is not in dispute that the land in dispute is an agricultural land and as per the State amendment, for relief of possession, Court *ad valorem* fee is not payable on the market value of the land. Reference in this regard can be made to the amendment made by the State of Punjab in Section 7 (V) of the Court Fees Act, 1870. In view thereof, there is no ground to interfere with the same. Therefore, this petition is dismissed.
