By virtue of the instant civil revision petition preferred under Section 227 of the Constituion of India, petitioner has sought setting aside the order dated March 07, 2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Anjala in case titled as 'Baljit Singh vs. Sitara Singh & others' whereby an application filed by the respondents/defendants for supplementing the affidavits of DW1 and DW2 as examination-in-chief by filing of supplementary affidavits of DW1 and DW2 has been allowed.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he does not press the instant petition and withdraws the same but liberty be granted to cross-examine the

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aforesaid witnesses effectively with regard to contents of the previous affidavits as well as the supplementary affidavits as well as dates mentioned therein.
