Petitioners-tenants are in revision assailing the order dated 10.03.2017 (**Annexure P-5**) passed by the Rent Controller, Panchkula, whereby the application filed by the tenants for supply of certain documents by the landlord was dismissed primarily on the ground that the same were a matter of evidence.

Upon notice, the respondent-landlord has put in appearance through his Advocate.

Learned counsel for the respondent-landlord submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous in the light of an application dated 01.07.2017 instituted by the landlord before the Rent Controller for placing on record nine (09) documents, which meet the requirement of the tenants for supply of documents raised in the present petition. He has supplied a copy of the said application enumerating the documents placed

on record to the counsel for the petitioners-tenants, who after examining the application concedes that the present revision petition has become infructuous.

In view of above, present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
