This revision petition has been filed against the order dated 21.12.2016 passed by Ld. Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Chandigarh, whereby the evidence of the petitioner has been ordered to be closed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he wishes to examine three witnesses, namely, Michel Reuben Dass-son of the petitioner; concerned official of Police Station Manimajra with entire record relating to complaint of Sanjeev Khanna and concerned official of Sector 34, Chandigarh with regard to FIR No.0478 dated 22.08.2013 registered against one Subhash Mehra under Section 420 IPC.

Mr. Suvir Sehgal, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that he would have no objection if the petitioner is given one opportunity to produce the evidence at her own risk and responsibility, making it clear that no further opportunity would be granted on any pretext.

In view of this, the revision is allowed and the impugned order is set aside. The Trial Court is directed to grant one last opportunity to the petitioner on 19.01.2017 to produce her entire evidence on her own risk and responsibility.

It is made clear that no further opportunity for production of evidence will be given to the petitioner on any pretext.
