Petitioner is in revision petition against the judgment and decree passed by both the Courts below.

Learned trial Court decreed the suit for recovery of Rs.25,000/- along with interest @ 10% per annum which has been modified by the First Appellate Court to 6% per annum.

Respondents had filed a suit for damages on account of malicious prosecution as the petitioner had filed an earlier suit due to political rivalry and dragged the plaintiffs to litigation for almost seven years. Both the Courts have appreciated the evidence available on the file and recorded a concurrent finding of fact that an earlier suit filed by the defendant was due to politics in the village.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere with the orders passed by the Courts.

Revision petition is dismissed.
