Feeling aggrieved against the impugned order dated 17.6.2014 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned trial court, defendant has approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is matter of record that the learned trial court granted ad-interim stay in favour of the plaintiffs-respondents, vide impugned order dated 17.6.2014.

After arguing the case for some time and realising that he will not be in a position to substantiate his arguments on merits, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer only for a direction to the learned trial court to decide the suit at an early date, which is pending for the last about three years.

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In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned trial court to make an endeavour to decide the pending civil suit at an early date, however, in accordance with law.

Disposed of, accordingly.
