On May 01, 2017, this Court passed the following order:-

*“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the respondent.*

*Notice of motion for 17.07.2017 subject to
depositing amount of arrears within a period of one week
with the trial Court.*

*However, in case, the amount is deposited within a
period of one week from today, the parties are directed to
be present in the Court on the next date of hearing.”*

On July 17, 2017, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly stated
that the arrears as directed by the Court have not been deposited. I granted one
more opportunity but the position remains same. Notice of motion was issued
subject to deposit of arrears of maintenance, which has not been complied
with. Therefore, I have no choice but to dismiss the revision petition.
