Feeling aggrieved against the alleged long pendency of their references, before the learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-respondent No.1, petitioners have approached this Court by way of present revision petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for a direction to respondent No.1, to decide the pending references under Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for short “the Act”) within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion was issued.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties at some length and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it may cause prejudice to the rights of either of the parties, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Presiding Officer,

Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-respondent No.1, to expedite the

proceedings of the pending references under Section 10 of the Act and decide the same at an early date, preferably within a period of one year from today.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made and directions issued, instant revision petition stands disposed of.
