RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

After having clear instructions from the petitioner, who is present in the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that in the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, he would not be in a position to substantiate his plea before this Court at this stage and he may be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition, however, with liberty to lay challenge to the order dated 05.02.2015 (Annexure P-2) before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and finding his abovesaid prayer to be a genuine one, the same is hereby accepted. Consequently, instant revision petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

It is also made clear that if the petitioner would challenge the order dated 05.02.2015 (Annexure P-2) before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law within a period of one month from today, the learned Court of competent jurisdiction shall decide the same not on account of delay

but on merits, because the petitioner had been pursuing his remedy before this Court under a bonafide wrong impression.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
