By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the setting aside of order dated February 13, 2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Panchkula vide which an application moved by the petitioners under Section 30 read with Order XI of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short 'CPC) and Section 151 CPC; has been dismissed.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners could not point out any infirmity or illegality in the impugned order. Even, otherwise, the matter which has been sought to be adjudicated through interrogatories is required to be proved by the parties by way of adducing

evidence in respect of their respective claims.

Finding no merit, illegality or perversity in the impugned order, the instant petition stands dismissed.
