Actual physical possession of the shop in question has been taken by the landlord through court orders executed by the bailiff. Though the landlord has put his lock on the shop, but goods belonging to the tenant are still lying within.

Learned counsel are agreed that the landlord would permit the tenant to remove his belongings from the shop and take them elsewhere within a period of one month i.e. on or before 30.09.2017.

To facilitate this arrangement, the landlord would give a spare key of the lock to the tenant, which he will be bound to return by the day he quits within the time allowed.

With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
