Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 24.4.2017, passed by the trial court, whereby application filed by the petitioners for examining handwriting and finger print expert in rebuttal evidence has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has assailed the order. He submits that approach of the trial court is erroneous and against law. According to him, as defendants have denied the execution of the agreement and dissolution deed dated 22.11.1946, it is necessary to get signatures of Lal Singh compared with his signatures on the written statement.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and given careful thought to the facts of the case.
