RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Present civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, at the hands of Gram Panchayat, is directed against the order dated 26.2.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned executing court, whereby applicants/claimants-respondents herein and other khewatdars were held entitled to share the compensation for their acquired land, which was forming part of Jumla Mustarka Malkan Wa Digar Haqdarani Hasab Rasad Arazi Khewat.

Notice of motion was issued.

When the case came up for hearing on 8.5.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place on record copy of Misal Haqiat followed by other jamabandis to show that the land was owned by the petitioner-Gram Panchayat.”

Neither the abovesaid order has been complied with by the learned counsel for petitioner, nor anybody has come present on behalf of the petitioner to press this revision petition.

Heard learned counsel for the respondents.

A bare perusal of the impugned order passed by the learned Additional District Judge would make it crystal clear that each and every relevant aspect of the matter was rightly examined, considered and appreciated in the correct perspective, before passing the impugned order. There is hardly any scope for this Court to interfere in the impugned order, while exercising its revisional jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

However, since neither the learned counsel for the petitioner is present, nor the abovesaid order has been complied with so far, present revision petition is dismissed as not pressed.
