In the index of this petition, it was held out that similar matters bearing CWP Nos.16990 and 16992 of 2001 stand admitted and fixed for regular hearing before the roster bench at serial No.397. This was the position on 30.01.2002.

This case was admitted to be heard with other matters but somehow has been detagged and connected cases have been decided in leading writ petition bearing ***CWP No.16992 of 2001, H.R.Wadhwa vs. Union of India & ors.*** That main petition was in a bunch of 17 writ petitions, which was dismissed by the learned Single Judge on 05.02.2002. It appears that for this reason that the petitioner has not deposited the process fee so far. There is no need to call upon the petitioner to appear on an adjourned date since the matter is indeed covered by the judgement in H.R.Wadhwa's case(supra).

Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed in terms of H.R.Wadhwa's case(supra).
