Present revision petition, at the hands of judgment debtor, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is directed against the order dated 3.4.2017 passed by the learned executing court, whereby on refusal to receive the notice by the petitioner-judgment debtor, warrants of sale for the attached property were issued.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the instant revision petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned executing court itself by moving an appropriate application showing his bonafide to pay the amount to the decree holder with a view to save his attached property to be sold.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
