After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner has filed an affidavit that the petitioner shall vacate and hand over actual physical possession of the premises in question on or before 31.3.2018 and he withdraws the present revision petition.

The said affidavit is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondent has no objection as such.

The arrears of rent shall be cleared by the petitioner-tenant within a period of one month from today and he shall continue to pay rent/mesne profit for the coming month by 7th of each month to the respondent-landlord, who shall issue a requisite receipt. In case the petitioner-tenant does not comply with the undertaking, it will be open to the respondent-landlord to take the possession of the premises in question forthwith and the Rent Controller concerned shall ensure that possession is delivered to the respondent-landlord even if police help is required.

With the aforesaid observations, the present revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
