Having been pointed by the learned counsel for the respondents that impugned order dated 27.1.2016 (Annexure P-7) is appealable and present revision petition could not be maintainable, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the instant revision petition with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate appeal before this Court.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for. However, it is clarified that since the petitioners had been availing the remedy of revision petition under a bonafide wrong impression, the respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation against the petitioners at the time of filing and arguing the appeal.
