Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inordinate delay in execution of the civil court decree dated 25.05.2009, petitioners-decree holders have approached this Court by way of instant revision petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to the learned executing Court for expeditious decision of the pending execution application.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that execution application bearing No.44 dated 21.09.2013 is still pending before the learned executing court. The decree which is being sought to be executed was passed by the learned court of competent jurisdiction as far back as on 25.05.2009 which has already attained finality between the parties by dismissal of Regular Second Appeal Nos.4807 and 4808 of 2012 by this Court vide its judgment dated 28.01.2014. He seeks disposal of the present

revision petition by issuing an appropriate direction to the learned executing

court for early decision of the pending execution application.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the nature of the prayer made, this Court feels it appropriate to dispose of the present revision petition without issuing notice to the respondents because direction is sought only against the executing court for early disposal of the pending execution application.

Consequently, without commenting anything on merits of the case, lest it may cause prejudice to the rights of either of the parties, instant revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned executing Court, to ensure early decision of the pending execution application and preferably within a period of six months from today, however, by passing an appropriate order strictly in accordance with law.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present revision petition is disposed of, however, with no order as to costs.
