Judgment debtor is in revision petition against the order dated 27.03.2017 dismissing his objection. There is a decree in favour of the bank dated 23.11.2013. The decree is in the form of an award passed by Mega Lok Adalat, Malerkotla which is equivalent to a decree of the Court. The judgment debtor claims that he has paid the entire amount, however, no receipt has been issued to him. He states that the payment has been made in the presence of Nambardar and another witness. However, judgment debtor has failed to produce any receipt of the payment made. Respondent decree-holder is a nationalized bank. If any amount is deposited, it has to be against a duly signed receipt.

In view of the discussion made above, I do not find any good ground to interfere in the order dated 27.03.2017.

Revision petition is dismissed.
