Case has been called twice. There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Same was the position on 25.05.2016 and on 27.03.2017.

Eviction order was passed on 24.03.2014 (Annexure P1), by the Rent Controller, Karnal, on the ground of *bona fide* requirement, for the need of the son of the respondent. The appeal against the said order was dismissed on 03.03.2015 (Annexure P2). A period of more than 2 years has expired by now and it is apparent that the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous as possession must have been taken by the respondent.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
