Petitioner (tenant) is in revision directed against the concurrent findings recorded by the Authorities below whereby the tenant has been ordered to be evicted from the demised shop bearing Private No.1, Ground Floor, forming part of building bearing no.63F, Khasra No.229 of 2017, 231/5 Min, situated at Gali No.3, Ram Gali, Gopal Nagar, Majitha Road, Amritsar, on the ground of personal necessity of the landlord, vide judgment dated 26.11.2014, passed by the Rent Controller, Amritsar duly affirmed by the Appellate Authority, Amritsar vide judgment dated 05.05.2015.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner

(tenant) submits that the present revision has become infructuous as the

respondents (landlord) has taken the vacant possession of the demised premises.
